MISSION STATEMENT

New Jersey Mini-Soccer will work alongside Charter Member Clubs, following US Soccer's Birth Year mandate, to offer age-appropriate training and 4v4 NJ Mini-Soccer Festivals for boys and girls of all ability levels, giving them more touches on the ball, opportunities to try new skills and most importantly, to have fun and grow a love of the game, without the stress or pressure of winning/losing.

WHO: Players born between January 1, 2010 and December 31, 2011

COACHING: All sessions and festivals will be ran by NJ Mini Soccer qualified staff

PROGRAM DETAILS

Commencing Fall 2017, New Jersey Mini-Soccer will offer all boys and girls born between January 1, 2010 – December 31, 2011 an opportunity to participate in an 8-week training program, plus a series of Festivals during the Fall (2017) & Spring (2018) seasons.

Each player will play in two games at each festival. Games are 40 minutes in length (4 x 10 minutes; 5-minute break in-between quarters), with a 60-minute break between each game. Players should look to play an equal amount of playing time during each festival. There are no Goalkeepers required for 4v4 soccer.

The rosters should not be formalized, allowing for rotation and movement during each festival. During Festival Play there will be minimal coaching; New Jersey Mini-Soccer Staff will introduce a set of specific rules of the game that have been developed for small-sided game participation. New Jersey Mini-Soccer Staff have been educated to let the game flow, and let the players learn from their mistakes.
